



% of students at or above benchmark growth




# **Student Engagement Summary**

### Actions

- Teach social/emotional curriculum targeted to the needs of our students
- Explicit teaching in 5-6 section focused on positive classroom culture and respectful realtionships
- Establish use of positive acknowledgement system within the vard
- Continue to enhance case management processes to ensure needs of all at-risk students being met

## Actions

- Initiating the DREAM BIG after school activity/extra curricular program across all terms
- Initiate DREAM BIG inquiry learning approach for Years 3-6
  - Planned within sections
  - Continue professional learning as needed
- Embed additional breaks, sport and physical activities within regular timetable
- Prioritising providing a range of student leadership opportunities Student Leadership - increase student responsibilities at recess and <u>lunchtime, buddy, program, Junior School Council/K-Kids, explicit teaching</u> of student leadership
- Year 3-4 to participate in Creative Arts Victoria Parnterships initiative with ACCA Term 3 and 4

## LEARNING, CATCH UP AND EXTENSION

#### Actions

- Embed Teaching Sprints in reading
- Extend Teaching Sprints to maths and writing
- Utilise tutor program to catch up students who made no or low growth in reading 2020
- Develop 'Writing Mindset' to increase student positive mindset and perceptions of themselves as writers
